CORONAVIRUS COVID-19 ADVISORY INFORMATION

Coronavirus COVID-19

The health and well-being of Christ Church, its members and friends is important to us. Therefore, this pamphlet has been prepared with information obtained from the CDC and the medical professionals of Christ Church.

How is the Coronavirus COVID-19 Spread?

- Person to person contact
- Close contact with someone (within 6 feet)
- Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes
- It may possibly spread even if an infected person shows no symptoms, it is not considered to be the main way the virus is spread
- Contact with infected surfaces and then touching your own mouth, nose or possibly your eyes; but it is not considered this is a main way the virus spreads

What Are the Symptoms?

Mild to severe respiratory illness with symptoms of:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of Breath

Methods of Prevention

- Vigorously wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing
- Avoid touching eyes, nose & mouth
- Use a hand sanitizer. It must have at least 60% alcohol when soap & water is not available
- Stay home when you are sick
- Cover your mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze and throw it away
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces
- Stay hydrated, drink plenty of fluids
- Please see your medical professional if you want ways to boost your immune system

- Parents, please demonstrate to your children good handwashing techniques
